Further, I understand that any additional amounts due to the school for tuition and fees not paid by TTPF are the full responsibility of either the Purchaser or the Beneficiary and must be paid by the deadline set by the school or the classes may be cancelled or the school may impose a penalty for late payment. I further understand that any refunds related to dropped classes after the school has billed TTPF, are between the Beneficiary and the school and that no Tuition Units will be restored to the account(s) designated above as a result of dropped classes after the school has billed TTPF.

NorthStar Financial Services Group, LLC ("NorthStar") is the plan manager and the Texas Tuition Promise Fund is distributed by NorthStar affiliate Northern Lights Distributors, LLC and administered by NorthStar affiliate Gemini Fund Services, LLC.
